

!	5. Penalty for Violations:
	The National Health Insurance Program is mandatory; any person who
	is qualified for this Program must enroll in the National Health
	Insurance Program. Any person who doesn't enroll is subject to a fine of
	NT\$3,000 to NT\$15,000. In addition, this person is required to pay the
	full premiums starting from the date he or she should have been
	enrolled. No benefits will be offered before the premiums are paid in
	full. A notice of penalty violation will be delivered in writing and the fine
	must be paid in due time. If the fines imposed remain unpaid, after a
	given period of time the case will be referred to the courts for
	compulsory enforcement.
